INFORMAL SEMINARS

During July and August twelve informal seminars, each lasting about an hour and a half, were held by the cardiovascular-renal workers and trainees. The first nine comprised a systematic review of the anatomy, physiology, and pathology of the kidney and were led by Drs. Bradley, Forster, Ladd, Raisz and Sheldon. The titles of the last three were: (1) Liver Circulation by Dr. Myers, (2) Cinchoninic Acid Compounds by Dr. Marshall and (3) Neurogenic hypertension by Dr. Stanley Nowak.
